



: Lough Neagh Stages : 4th July 2010 : Final Regulations

Competition door numbers for the event will be provided by the club at documentation scrutiny. **Entry list attached**

Scrutiny: note amendments to SR 6

All competitors are to report to the **service area** in the estate, entrance via roguery road BT41 3TJ on **Saturday 3rd July 2010**.

- **Cars 1 to 15** **5pm**
- **Cars 16 to 30** **5:30pm**
- **Cars 31 to 45** **6pm**
- **Cars 46 to 60** **6:30pm**
- **Cars 61 +** **7pm**

Scrutiny finishes at 8pm.

It is the entrants' responsibility to ensure their vehicle is entered in the **correct class** as scrutineer has been instructed to check any vehicle under query at the clubs request, refer to SR7 for classes. **The onus is on the entrant to ensure that their vehicle complies with Road Traffic Act.**

Noise test of all competing vehicles will take place at 8am Sunday 4th July 2010.

Stage familiarisation:

Driver and co driver **only** will have the opportunity to familiarise themselves with the track on **Saturday 3rd July** by foot or pedal cycle. (Maps provided) **Only after mechanical and documentation scrutiny has been completed. Stage familiarisation Finishes at 9pm, Competitors are not permitted on the stages on Sunday morning.**

Service area:

Only one service vehicle per crew is permitted in the service area. Trailers are to be parked as directed by the marshal. **All crews must use ground sheets, failure to do so will result in automatic exclusion.**

Please respect the grounds and place any rubbish in the bins provided. All mechanical and refuelling waste **must** be removed. Please note spectators will have access to the service area and **safety is a priority.** The use of any form of motorised or pedal transportation in or around the estate during the event is strictly prohibited.

Refuelling:

Please read the service area risk management notices regarding refuelling procedures. Fire extinguishers will be in position in the service area please familiarise yourself with location before any refuelling is carried out.

Driver briefing:

All competitors **must** attend briefing at 9; 15am in the service paddock. **No exceptions**

Start:

Cars will start from the service area, service out will be arrival control for stages 1,2,3,4 first competing car off the start line at 10am; cars will start at 30 second intervals.

Results:

Provisional results will be posted at immediately after the event these results will become final 30minutes after the event at Mc Nallys inn, 62 Hillhead road toomebridge. Carvery meals available during evening. Secure parking in SDC trailers yard opposite venue. Awards presentation will take place at 7.30pm. Reminder:

Withdrawals must be via email/fax/ letter; refunds will be issued minus admin fee. Failure to notify the secretary in writing will result in no refund being issued.

Insurance Reminder:

The club has applied for blanket cover under the lockton motor sports club scheme. This will provide competitors who need the third party cover necessary to meet the RTA requirements on the road sections of the event. You must be able to comply with the following:

- Over 21 and held a full licence for at least 6 months.
- Not more than 1 fault accident in last 3 years.
- No more than maximum of 6 speeding points on licence.
- No physical or mental disabilities.

If you can comply with the above premium: £20 as per entry form

If you cannot comply with ANY of the above a letter of acceptance is required and premium is: £40.00. Contact the competition secretary for Declaration form to apply for letter of acceptance prior to event minimum 4 days to allow sufficient time for letter to be issued.

Competitors who have extended their own insurance to cover competing vehicle must bring a copy to scrutiny when signing on.
